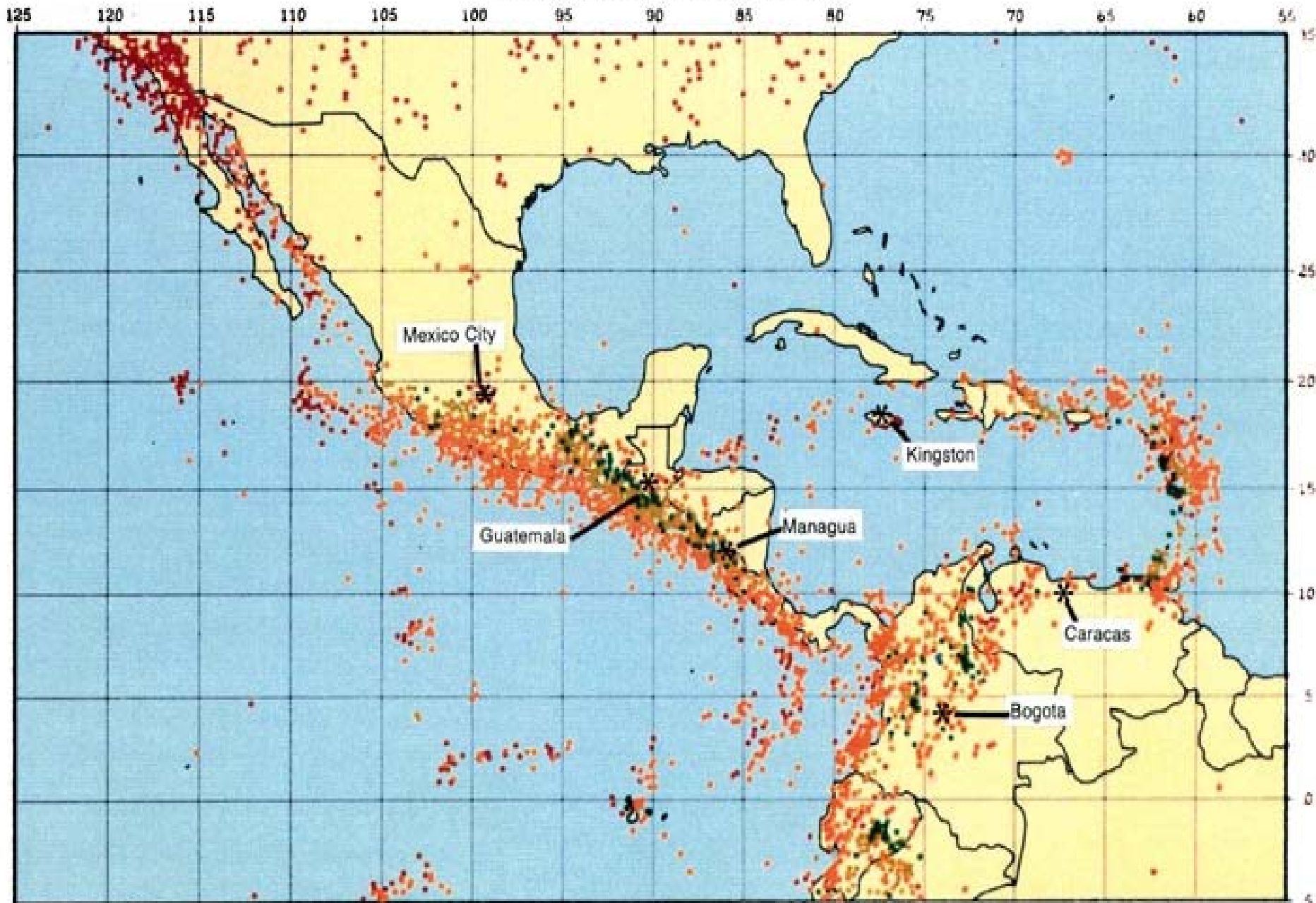


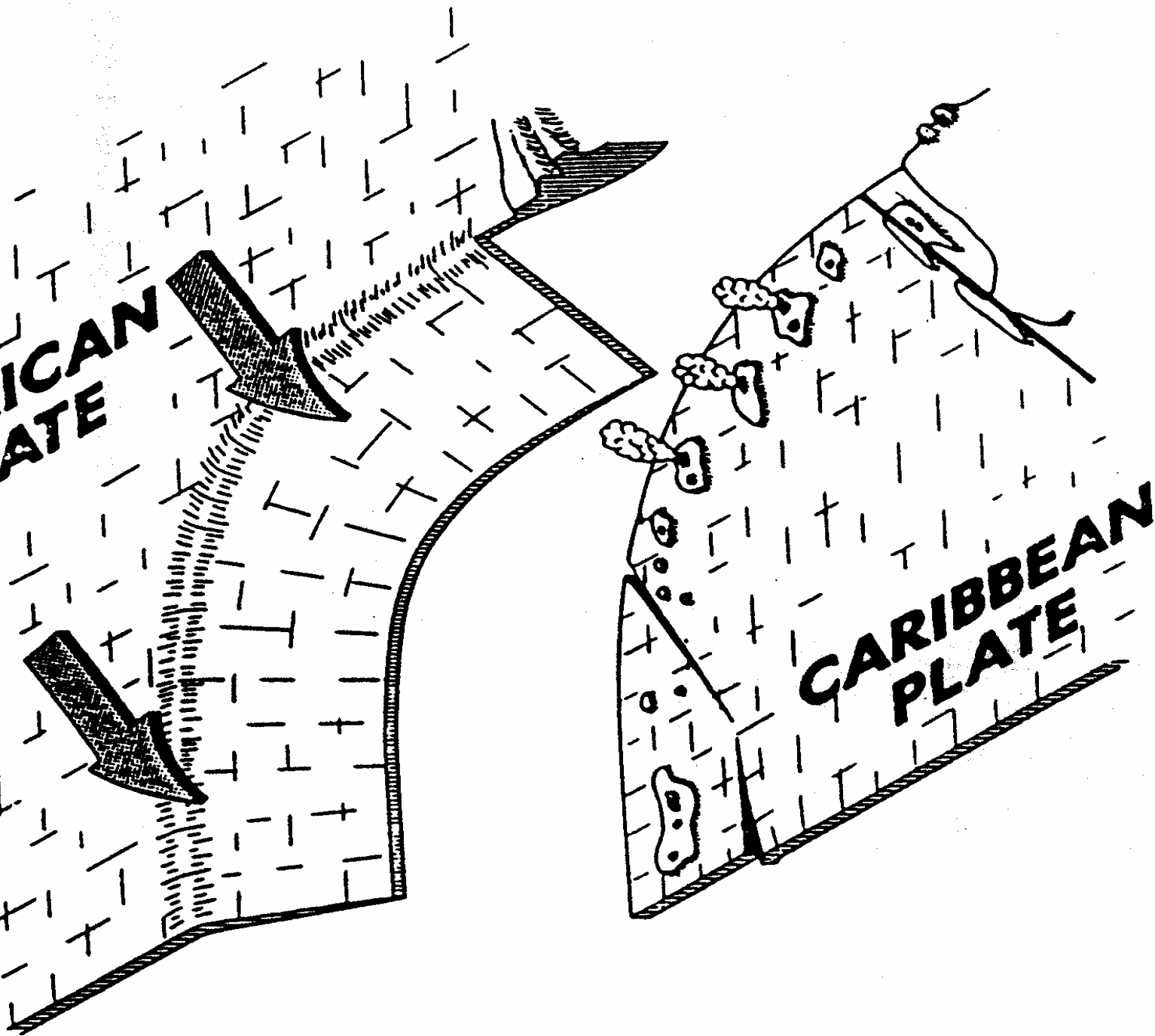

PREPARING FOR A RECURRENCE OF THE “BIG ONE”

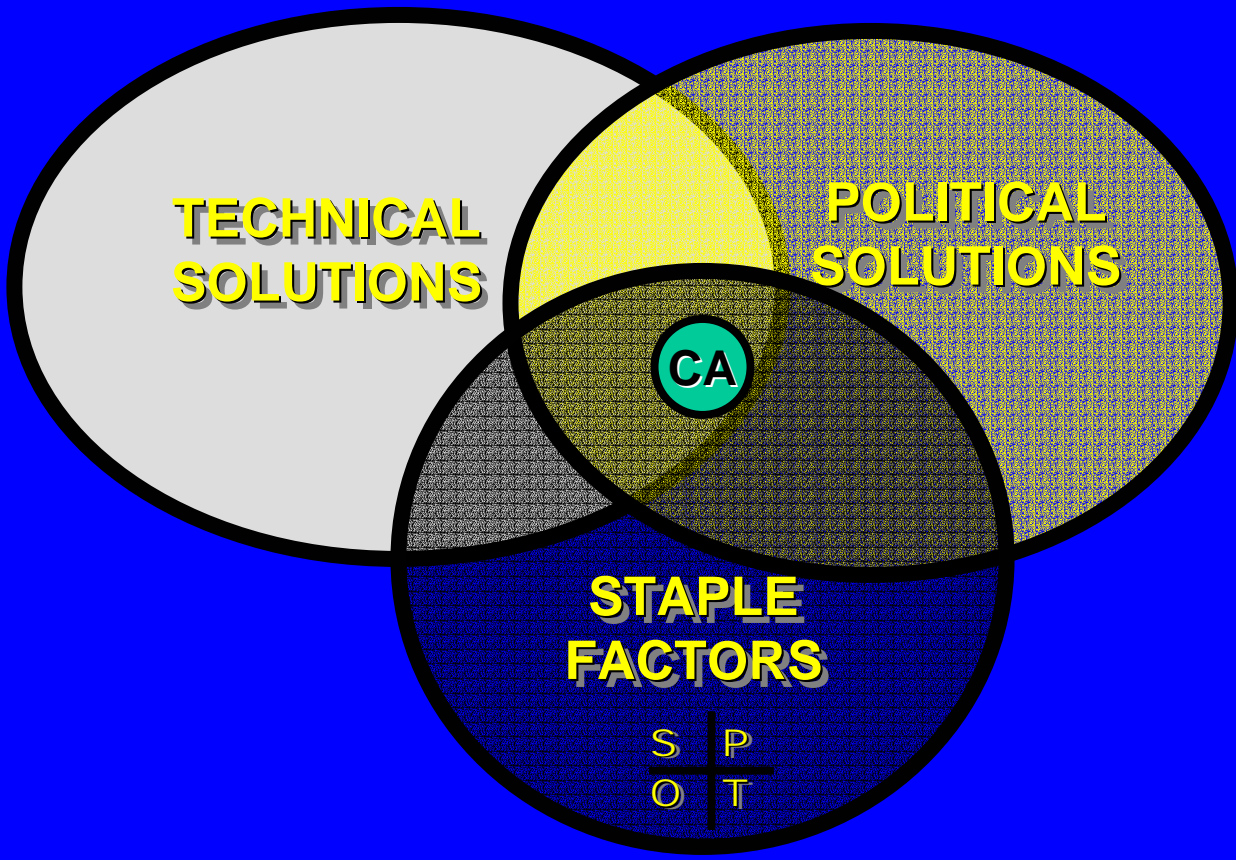

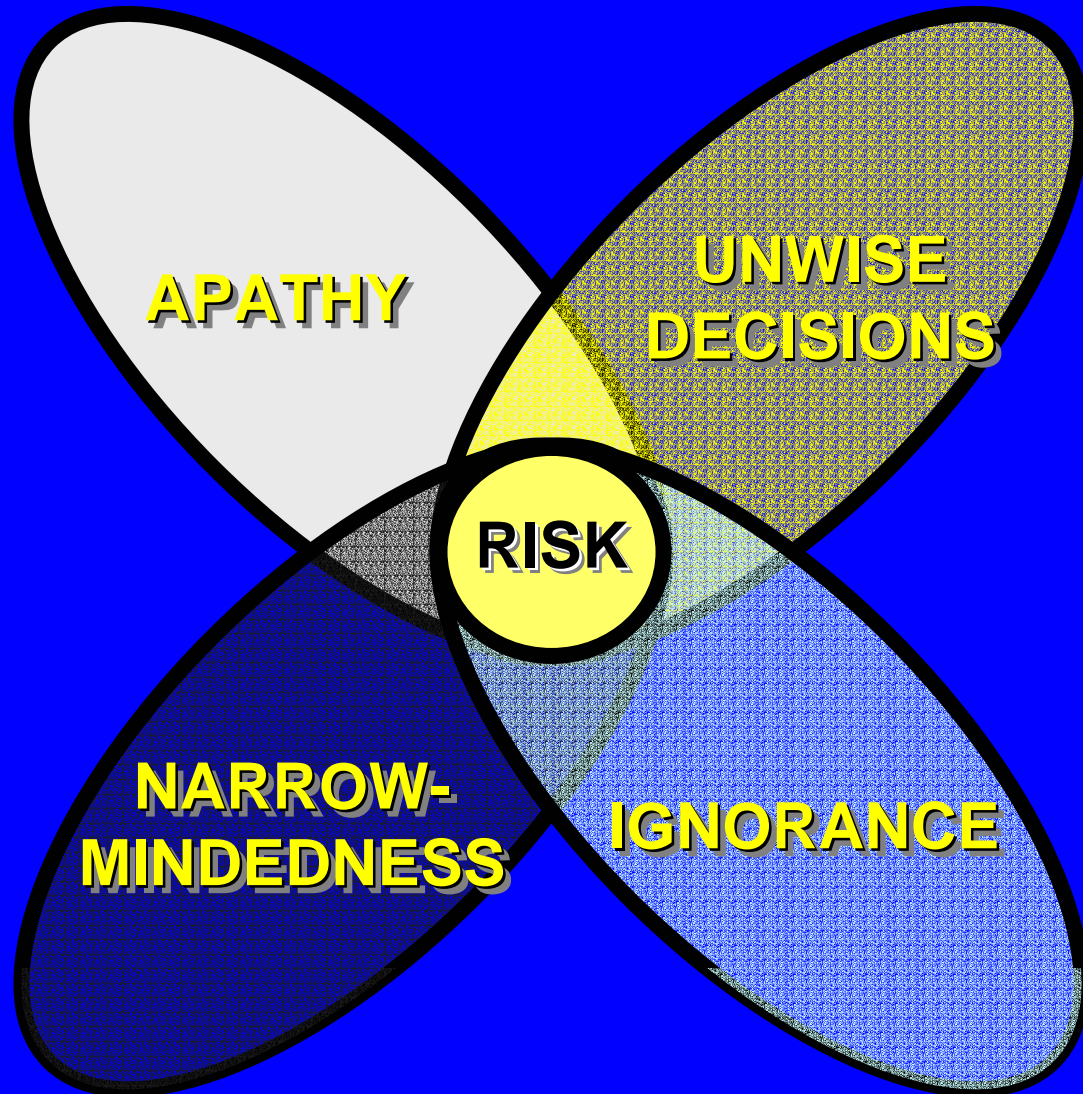
FACT: THE COMMON AGENDA IS BASED ON PUERTO RICIO'S **STAPLE** FACTORS



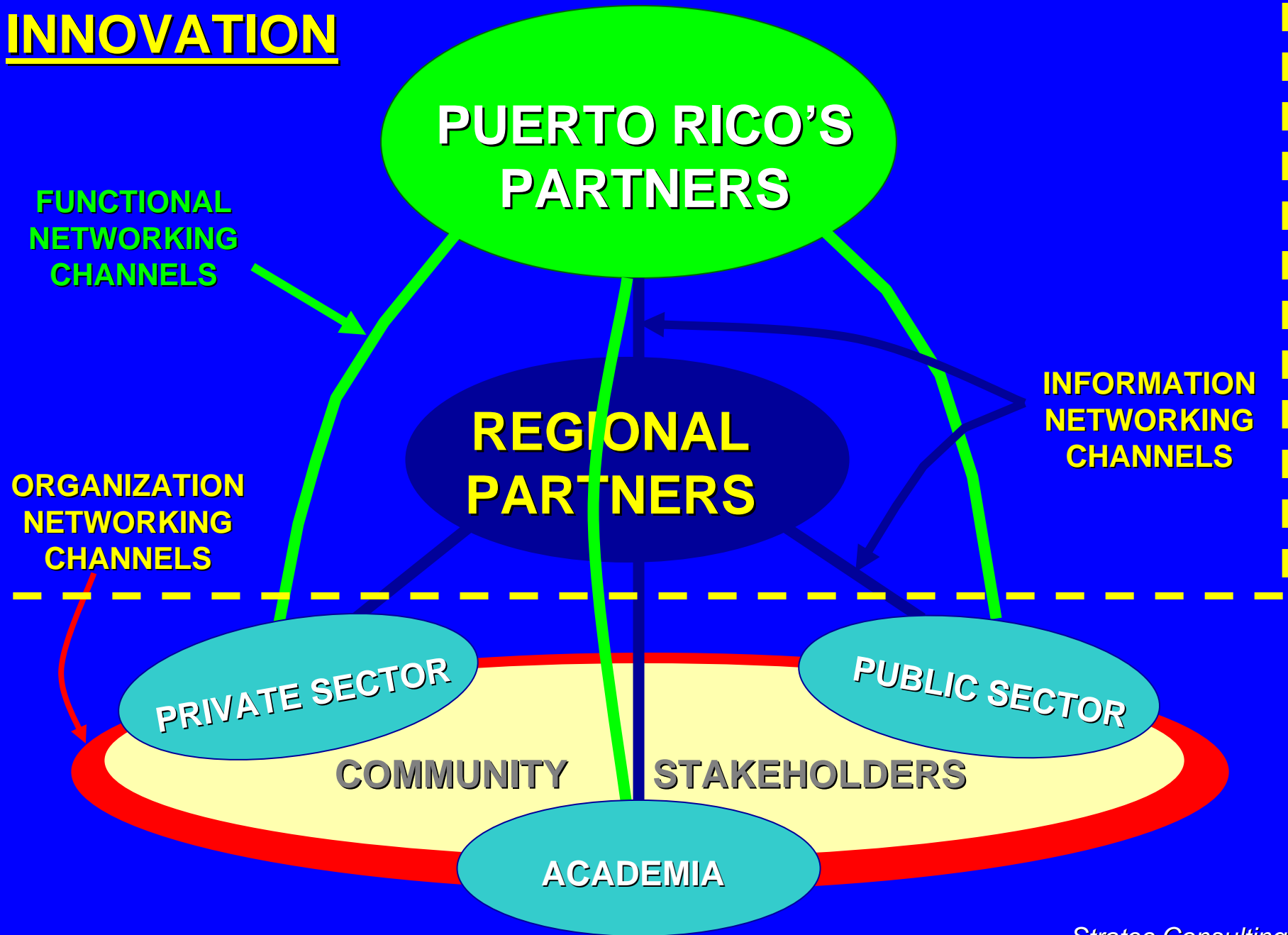
CRITICAL ACTIONS

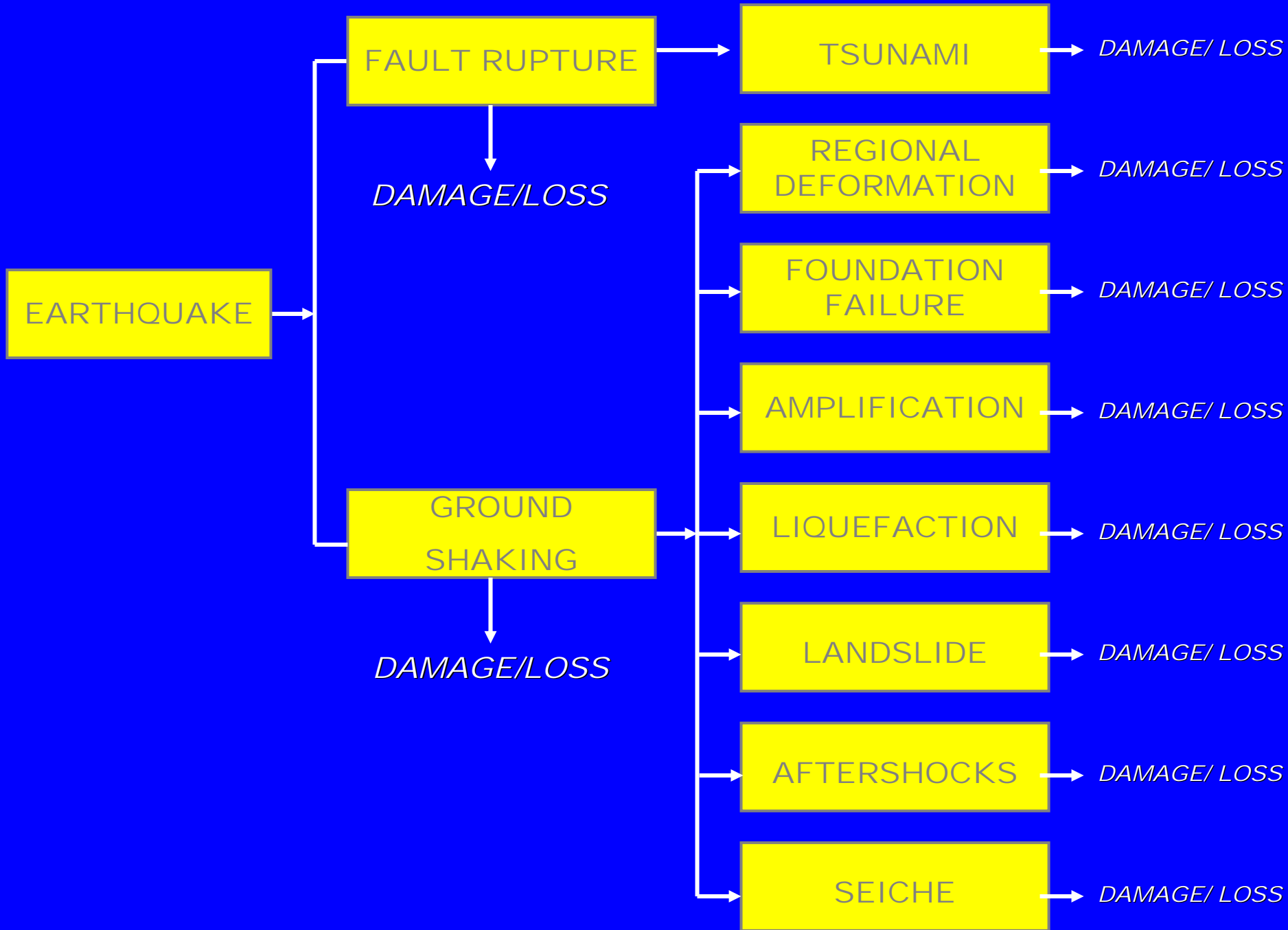
